



## Image Slider

The image slider is located in the Content Editor Page creation module.



You have four images sizes to select from these are required for the slider to operate properly

**Adding an image slider**

The first example below shows the HTML to include in the "Source" view of your page for a centred image slider. The examples below also include how to add a web link to one of the images in the slide show.

This second example shows the HTML for a left justified image slider with text or other content to the right. It is recommended to set the slider size above to 500x375 if menus are also to be displayed.

In the example HTML there are five images which will be used in the slider, if you use fewer images delete the appropriate number of lines.



## Images

The first step is to select, resize and load your images to the **File Manager** in Management **Menu**. Its suggested you create a library of Slider images by slider. <sup>1</sup>

This makes it easier to control the content of the Image library in your file manager and the slider itself.

## Slider

Example of HTML: to paste into your **SOURCE Display Page**, the Group/118 (the number is your group ID). You will see the group ID repeated in the file manager header data.

Depending on how deep in the file manager you have placed the image the **images** must be changed to reflect the path and the image-1 to the name of the image. The image caption should be change to a descriptive text of the image or left blank.

In some cases you might wish to place a link on the image to take the user to a page containing more detail related to your image. Line 3 above is an example of a link to another web page.

In the above example the images are placed centrally on the page you have created.

<sup>1</sup> HTML links are limited in length please be aware of this when creating directory and file names. Also it's better to use a \_ (Underscore) rather than blank in these names a blank takes three spaces in the path and name combination.



HTML example 2
