In Agoria you can add a poll to content and set a yes, no, no opinion response. This will display a question below the page content with the space for yes no and no opinion along with space for further comment.

**Include Vote**  No  Yes (Add a vote panel to the page)

**Vote Title**   
Required if Include Vote = Yes (Max 50 chars)

**Vote Open Date**   (e.g. 12/Apr/2012)

**Vote Close Date**   (e.g. 30/Apr/2012)

**Required Votes**  (Minimum votes required for a valid result)

**Show Votes List**  No  Yes (Show Votes List with comments)

**Name in List**  No  Yes (Show the voter name in the Votes List)

**NOTE** If "Required Votes" number is blank or zero, the vote will end once the vote close date has passed. If "Required Votes" number greater than 0 is entered, the vote will only end when both the close date has passed AND the required number of votes have been counted.

Select "Include Vote" this will add the Voting / polling to the page, remember your question should only require a yes no answer with the option of no opinion and comments. It's very simple ideal for assessing an event.

Provide an opening date and a closing date for the vote /poll, also select number to make the sample valid.

To make the vote results visible on the page select Public or any of the other access permissions such as member.
